

#### **MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR 6-2015**

TO : All Area Directors, PPSA Area Coordinators, NROI Area

SUBJECT : Chronograph shall be mandatory for all Level II & III Matches

# I. Background

As per the January 2015 IPSC Rules, the Chronograph Stage in Level II and Level III matches is only Recommended and no longer Mandatory. (Appendix A 1: Sec. No. 15)

## II. Objective

1. To prevent the deterioration of shooting skills by shooting minor loads in matches which affects the ability to manage recoil when shooting major loads during International Matches.

### III. Guidelines & Procedures

- 1. It shall be the responsibility of the Match Director, and Range Master to ensure that a Chronograph, Weighing Scale, Bullet Puller, & Calculator in good working condition be available during Level II and Level III matches.
- 2. It is recommended that the Chronograph should have Infrared Screens with back-up battery pack or Lighting set to make sure that chronograph testing will not be disrupted due to inclement weather or poor lighting conditions.
- 3. The Chronograph should be properly set-up and verified each day by Match Officials per rule 5.6.2 and all its subheadings.
- 4. The weighing scale should also be verified and tested for accuracy.
- 5. The Range Master must appoint a competent Chrono Officer.

#### IV. Administrative Instructions & Sanctions

- 1. This circular will form part of the sanctioning policy of the PPSA.
- 2. Non-compliance will be sanctioned by forfeiture of points for the Match Director, Range Master, and Chrono Officer for the match.
- Any circular inconsistent with the provisions of this Circular are hereby repealed or amended, accordingly

### V. Effectivity

This memorandum shall take effect immediately.
